Oil India Limited (OIL) has awarded Fabtech Pune, a LSTK contract of Rs 433 crore for constructing Secondary Tank Farm (STF) at Duliajan. Other than storage tanks, the facility includes numerous mechanical pack-

ages, fire protection system, plant piping, process packages, pumps & dosing systems, complete civil, electrical, instrumentation works and plant commissioning with PGTR. The duration of the project is 24 months.

Fabtech Pune has received orders worth Rs 110 crore through three orders for setting up bulk LPG storage facilities. It received order worth Rs 60 crore from Numaligarh Refineries Limited, Assam, for setting up 4x1000 MT storage facility, order worth Rs 37 crore from Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) for setting up 3x1450 MT storage facility at Palghat and order worth Rs 14 crore from IOCL for setting up 3x600 MT storage facility at Gurgaon.

Fabtech is also geared up

to participate at similar bigger projects coming up in Odisha and Gujarat.

The company has also received export orders worth Rs 100 crore for supply of static equipments and majority of this order book is for equipment supplies to Dangote Refinery in Nigeria. It received an order worth of Rs 72 crore for supply of electrical penetration assemblies from Nuclear Power Corporation of India Limited (NPCIL).

Fabtech Pune has successfully completed orders worth Rs 1,000 crore for companies like IOCL Paradip refinery, Diesel Hydro Treater Project at HPCL Visakh Refinery, Oil India Limited's Moran, Jorhat, Tengakhat and Duliajan tank farms, BPCL's Kochi refinery and Simon India Limited among others.
